He said that the result of the survey is that we will continue to recognise each of these three award types as we do now and that in fact all three categories had moved further in favour of the status quo than at the last survey. John read out the percentages of each one.

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

A most unusual club year has come to an end and I am happy to report that we have come through it remarkably well!

I will talk about finances first. The lockdown had the potential to make things very difficult for the club which is, after all, in the hospitality industry. However with the support of the members, careful management led by Alan Proctor, and with assistance from the wage subsidies, we were able to finish the year with a net profit of \$21680. This was a similar result to those of the last two years.

On the fishing front the lockdown affected us significantly. We lost both the Yamaha Trailerboat Tournament and the Junior Tournament, not to mention many weeks of fishing!

Our total catch for the season was 409 fish, compared with 766 last year and 1055 two seasons ago! Broadbill numbers doubled to 8, blue marlin were steady again, but striped marlin numbers were very concerning, down by 33% after a 25% drop last season!

On the positive side, our 49 yellowfin were the most since 2006!

The highlight of the season had to be the Kubota Billfish Classic, revamped by new convener Thomas Maxwell which attracted 80 boats even though it was on the eve of lockdown!

Individual highlights included Tony Tucker's 265.2kg broadbill, our heaviest fish for the season, the pending World Smallfry Record 242.8kg blue marlin caught by Mitchell Oliveira and "Fysshier" being the top scoring boat in NZ in the Nationals.

Well done to "Sol-E-Mar" for being our top scoring boat for the season and to crew member Darryl Williams for being the Club's champion angler!

Congratulations to those just mentioned and to all members who will win trophies, pins or certificates at our upcoming prizegiving on September 26.

That brings me to our AGM and I am pleased to say that all Officers and Committee are available to again serve the club. With no new nominations, an election will not be needed, and our club will have stability going forward.

Once again on behalf of you all, I would like to express thanks to all who have made this successful year possible. Patron Warren Harris, Vice President Gordon McIvor, Committee: Scott Farrell, Melissa Ford, Brad Johnson, Rod Johnson, Bryn Jones, Dugal MacFarlane, Thomas Maxwell and Graeme Tucker, Tournament Committee: John Booker, Aaron Costello, Carolyn Franklin, Julz Pearson and Brent Watts, the Gamebase team and the weighmasters. You are all volunteers who have given of your time and skills to help the club provide the opportunities that it does to all members.

Our administrative, kitchen, bar and cleaning staff, well led by manager Alan Proctor, have all played their part in creating an environment we can all enjoy.

As always our many sponsors have done us proud! The club would not be the same without them. In a year when she was unable to fish, Margaret has again shown me great support and has helped out with both Gamebase and photography.

Although we never know what's round the corner, I am sure we can look forward to the coming season with confidence.
